Venturing is a youth development program of the Boy Scouts of America for young men and women who are 13 (and have completed the eighth grade) through 20 years of age.

Venturing's purpose is to provide positive experiences to help young people mature and to prepare them to become responsible and caring adults.

Venturing is based on a unique and dynamic relationship between youth, adult leaders, and organizations in their communities. Local community organizations establish a Venturing crew by matching their people and program resources to the interests of young people in the community. The result is a program of exciting and meaningful activities that helps youth pursue their special interests, to grow, to develop leadership skills, and to become good citizens.

CENTRAL REGION - AREA 6 VENTURING SUMMIT September 10-11, 2011 @ Kikthawenund Scout Camp, Noblesville, Indiana

WHO: The Second Annual Area 6 Venturing Summit is design specifically for the Council or District Venturing Key 3 (Adult Volunteer, Youth VOA President, and Venturing Professional). Other Council or District VOA Officers, or adults with a lead Council or District Venturing responsibility are encouraged to attend. WHERE: Kikthawenund Scout Camp is the Crossroads of America Council Camp located 20 minutes north of Noblesville, Indiana. There are three new, heated bunk-style cabins that each sleep 24. Two other cabins which accommodate 10 each are available.

COST: The cost for the weekend will be \$35. This will cover accommodations for Saturday night, lunch and dinner on Saturday, breakfast on Sunday, cracker barrel, and meeting materials.
