National Advanced Youth Leadership Experience

The National Advanced Youth Leadership Experience (NAYLE) is the ultimate in training experiences for youth leaders, both young men and women. It is conducted for older Scouts who have the potential for being on the staff of the council junior leader training or youth leader training conference. The NAYLE program takes place this year for the first time at the Rayado Leadership Mesa, approximately 8 miles from base camp and situated in the beautiful foothills viewing Urraca Mesa and Crater Peak.

To be eligible to attend, a youth leader must have completed NYLT, be between 14-21, and meet the Philmont Scout Ranch height and weight requirements. So sign up while you still can; positions are filling up for the courses!


