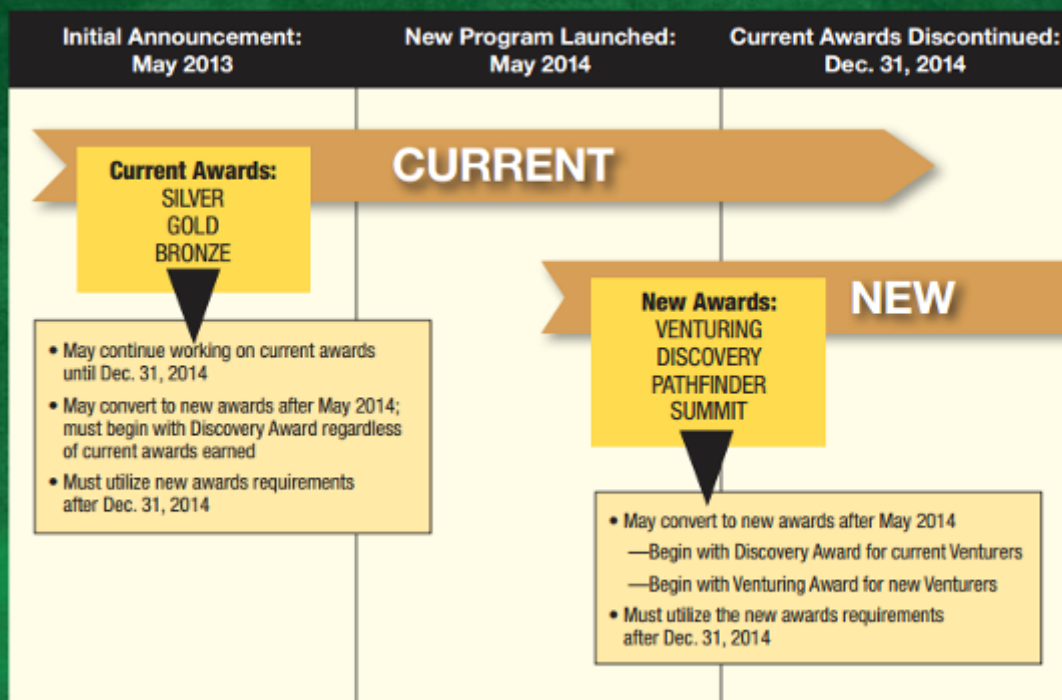
Venturing Program Update

As of June 1, 2014, you can work on the new Venturing Awards. The new Venturing Awards are designed to help Venturers grow in the areas of adventure, leadership, personal growth, and service.

This is a reminder for those youth that if you are wanting to earn the Bronze, Gold or Silver Awards then you need to complete them before December 31. That is just SIX months, so get going if you want to have these awards.

Now if you want to start earning the new awards, get on your mark, get set... go! You can begin working on the new Venturing awards program. Venturing, Discovery, Pathfinder, and Summit Award.

DISCOVERY AWARD

Award Focus: Participation

- Small-group management skills training
- Earn first-aid and CPR certifications
- Goal-setting training
- Time-management training
- Minimum of 24 hours of service
- Establish and achieve at least one personal goal, including peer and advisor review

PATHFINDER AWARD

Award Focus: Leadership

- Project management training
- Plan and lead at least one crew activity of one day or longer
- Serve in elected leadership position for six months or more
- Experiential training in conflict resolution, communications, group dynamics, cooperation, and ethical controversies
- Plan and lead activity to enhance crew sustainability
- Plan and participate in service of 36 hours or more
- Establish and achieve two personal goals

- Mentoring and coaching skills training
- Mentor a crew member in planning and leadership of crew activity
- Serve in elected leadership position for six months

- Complete goal development and planning for all realms of personal growth
- Create personal code of conduct for review by peers and adult advisors
- Lead and guide ethical controversy and conflict resolution discussion with crew

SWIFT & NYLT

John S. Swift Base

Every week at Swift is packed with great program at a Venturing specific camp. Activities can include challenge course, water skiing, sailing, mountain biking, tubing, horseback riding, shotguns, rifles, archery, and more! Each week also has a theme that will include theme specific activities! During these weeks you can still do all the traditional Swift activities, but you can also choose to participate in some of the other great activities we've got going on.

June 22-June 28 Sea Scout and Pirate Invasion

July 6 - July 12 Are You Tough Enough?

During these weeks we'll have experts supplementing the Swift staff, and we will be bringing in extra equipment for these programs. Imagine the waterfront full of sailboats, or taking a climb on a natural rock face-- at night. Registration for 2014 is open now. Crews and Ships get first priority. To reserve a slot is \$25, and the rest is due before camp. Pay by camper savings on May 1, and you'll get an early payment discount. A provisional (individual) signup will also be available. National Youth Leadership Training, or NYLT, is a youth leadership program designed to give Venturers the skills they need to go above and beyond in their roles as leaders in their Crew and their life. It is taught by youth for youth with activities and games designed to reinforce concepts explained in presentations. The interactive learning keeps participants engaged and make sure they really have the material down. There are several opportunities for Venturers to participate in leadership this summer. The Greater St. Louis Area Council is hosting Venturing NYLT Pack and Paddle this experience July 21st-27th! NYLT will be held at S-F Scout Ranch just south of Farmington, MO.
