This year, six teams raced to see if they qualified for the 2016 Konch Cup, or, in other words, to be in the National Sea Scout Regatta. It'll be a while until the results are in from the race, but hopefully an Area 2 ship has qualified.

The race was held at the Edison Boat Club in Detroit, MI which is affiliated with the local crew/ship 1148. Functioning as both a Venturing Crew and a Sea Scouting Ship, it helped to run the event and have at least one contending ship.

Area 2 President Jacob Hardy visited the regatta following NOAC. It was a "race I wish I participated in." The regatta will be in Detroit for at least the next four years in early august so make sure you don't miss it!


